#### EPHESIANS 6:10


FINALLY, MY BRETHREN, BE STRONG IN THE LORD, AND IN THE POWER OF HIS MIGHT.

### STRENGTH



2. Where are you in this process from Romans 5:3-4? It starts with rejoicing in your sufferings.




HOPE = EXPECTATION, TRUST, CONFIDENCE


